# REQUIREMENTS FOR PAPER AUTHORS

The paper will be printed in A4 format, within a maximum of 10 pages, with edges left / right or up / down 20 mm in Microsoft Word with Times New Roman 12 in a row.

*Title* will be written with capital letters, bold.

Name and affiliation of the authors are written in a row under the title, paragraph right, italic.

Academic rank, name and surname of the scientific coordinator are written at one row below the names and affiliation of the authors, left aligned, italic.

**The summary** is written in English, two rows away from the front row containing academic rank, full name of the scientific coordinator, and contains no more than 10 rows, left / right aligned paragraph (*Justify*), Italic.

**Keywords** will be written in English at one row from the summary line, left / right aligned paragraph (*Justify*), Italic.

*The titles of sections and subsections* should be written in Romanian (or English), with bold font, at a distance of 15 mm from the edge.

**The paper text** will be written in Romanian (or English), at a distance of 15 mm from the edge, left / right aligned (Justify).

*The tables* are framed in text, numbered in the right corner, and the title is written in the upper left.

*Figures* should be placed in the text and should be numbered.

Formulas and equations are inserted in the text and should be numbered in the right.

*Paragraphs* will start at a distance of 15 mm from the edge, aligned left / right (Justify).

**Footnotes** will be numbered in their text apparition order and are written in Times New Roman 10, at one line, left / right aligned paragraph (justify) following the example given below:

*The bibliography* is written at the end of the paper after two blank lines.

\* foreign students papers will be written in a foreign scientific recognized language
