REQUIREMENTS FOR PAPER WRITING AT THE CONFERENCE

The paper will be written in A4 format, up to a maximum of 10 pages, with the left / right and bottom / top edges of 20 mm, respectively, in Microsoft Word with *Times New Roman* 12 font, in single line spacing.

The title of the paper will be written centered, in capital letters, bold.

The name, surname and affiliation of the authors are written in single line spacing under the title of the paper, right paragraph, italics.

The teaching degree, the name and surname of the scientific coordinators are written in single line spacing under the name, surname and affiliation of the authors, left paragraph, italics.

The abstract is written in Romanian and English, Times New Roman, font 12, two lines apart from the line containing the teaching degree, the name and surname of the scientific coordinators, and will have a minimum of 100 words and a maximum of 150 words, left / right paragraph (Justify), italics.

Keywords will be written in English and in a summary line, left / right paragraph (Justify), italics.

The titles of the sections and subsections are written in Romanian, in bold font, at a distance of 15 mm from the edge.

The text of the paper will be written in Romanian, at a distance of 15 mm from the edge, aligned left / right (Justify).

The tables are framed in the text, numbered in the upper right, and the title is written in the upper left.

The figures will be framed in the text and will be numbered.

The formulae and equations inserted in the text will be numbered to the right of the page.

The paragraphs of the paper will start at a distance of 15 mm from the edge, aligned left / right (Justify).

Footnotes are numbered in the order in which they are used in the text and are written in *TimesNewRoman* 10 font, one line, left / right (Justify), according to the example below:

The bibliography shall be written at the end of the paper after two free lines.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPATION

Depending on the epidemiological evolution, the Conference will take place both in face-to-face format (at the headquarters of the "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" Police Academy in Bucharest, Aleea Privighetorilor no. 1A, sector 1), and in online format at <https://www.academiadepolitie.ro/elearning.html>, (*B.A. university studies e-learning platform*), using the Google Meet application. The works will be presented in Romanian. A person can participate as sole author or first author with a single work. - **May 23, 2021** - sending the paper in final format to the correspondence section;
- **June 03, 2021** - communication of acceptance / rejection of the paper by the organizers, following the review process and verification of compliance with academic standards of originality.
